



Reminder. March 5th is Ash Wednesday, Mass will be at St. Mary's at 8:15am and Sacred Heart at 6:00pm. Please see Lenten regulations for WEDNESDAY fasting and abstaining.

Reminder. Daylight Savings Time begins on Sunday, March 9th. Please do not forget to set your clocks 1 hour forward on Saturday night March 8th.

Lenten Regulations: The season of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, March 5th Lenten regulations are as follows: 1. Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays in Lent, and Good Friday.

2. In addition to abstaining from meat, Catholics who have celebrated their 18th birthday, until they celebrate their 59th birthday, are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Those who are bound to this regulation may eat only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.
