Reports:

1. Reading & approval of February 10, 2025, meeting – Chris Zinda

Debbie Adamski moved approval of the minutes. Pat Gagas seconded.

2. Financial Report as of February 28, 2025– Judy Wroblewski

St. Ambrose PCCW General account - \$8,562.70
St. Ambrose Seminarian account - \$2,307.13
St. Ambrose PCCW Station of the Cross account - \$20,535.57
General checking account as of March 10, 2025 - \$19,707.46 (\$4,000.00 will be transferred into the St. Ambrose Station of the Cross Account.)
The Bingo net profit is \$3,161.94. Two more invoices need to come in so the net profit will change.

The PCCW received a bill for March for \$1,783.60 for hosts and votive candles. They did pay an invoice for \$1,783.60 in October. The PCCW was asked if they would also pay for the votive candles. Which they have been doing. One votive candle costs \$3.00. This money goes back to the parish. At the votive stand is a request for \$3.00 per candle that is lit.

Additional kitchen repairs besides the ceiling repair need to be made where the PCCW will have to cover the cost. After a discussion Debbie Adamski moved that the PCCW pay \$1,000.00 of the March invoice and in the future the cost of votive candles will not be paid by the PCCW. Virginia Groshek seconded the motion. Motion passed unaniously by voice vote.
