Dear Parishioners:

I am pleased to inform you that "Phase 2" of the restoration project will begin shortly. Phase 2 will consist of the painting of the ceiling of the nave and work in the choir loft, replacing the speakers, and possibly restoration of the Stations of the Cross (this is being investigated as to whether we can do this - I will let you know the result).

Starting April 28, 2025, the preparatory work will begin. This will consist of placing protective covering on the pews, the floors, and the sanctuary area, removal of statuary and the Stations. After this the scaffolding will be erected. This will take at least a week to do. Once that is done, the painting will begin. It is estimated that the project will be completed by mid-August.

Because of the extensive work involved, the church will not be usable. Masses will be held in the basement during this time. There will be no funeral Masses or funeral luncheons at SH while the project is going on.

I again want to thank the beautification committee for their excellent work, and for everyone who contributed to the "Heart Speaks to Heart" Campaign. We should be very happy as to what has been accomplished.

ASH Reminder. March 5th is Ash Wednesday, Mass will be at St. Mary's at 8:15am and Sacred Heart at 6:00pm. Please see Lenten regulations for WEDNESDAY fasting and abstaining.

Lenten Regulations: The season of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, March 5th Lenten regulations are as follows: 1. Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays in Lent, and Good Friday.

2. In addition to abstaining from meat, Catholics who have celebrated their 18th birthday, until they celebrate their 59th birthday, are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Those who are bound to this regulation may eat only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.



Stations of the Cross will be starting on Sunday, March 9th at 9:25am at St. Mary's and on Wednesday, March 12th at 6:15pm at Sacred Heart. Sacred Heart School children will be having Stations at 2:00pm on the following

Fridays: March 7th, March 14th, March 28th, and April 11th. Anyone is welcome to attend.


